



JPAE Home page is your one stop guide to **Joint Polytechnic Admissions Exercise**, providing you with all the information from deciding on your course selection to submission of your application.

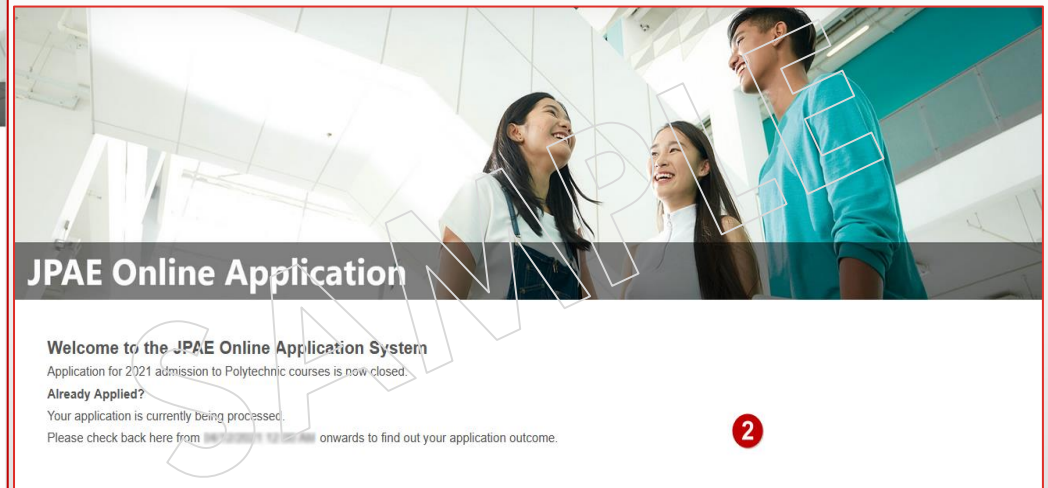
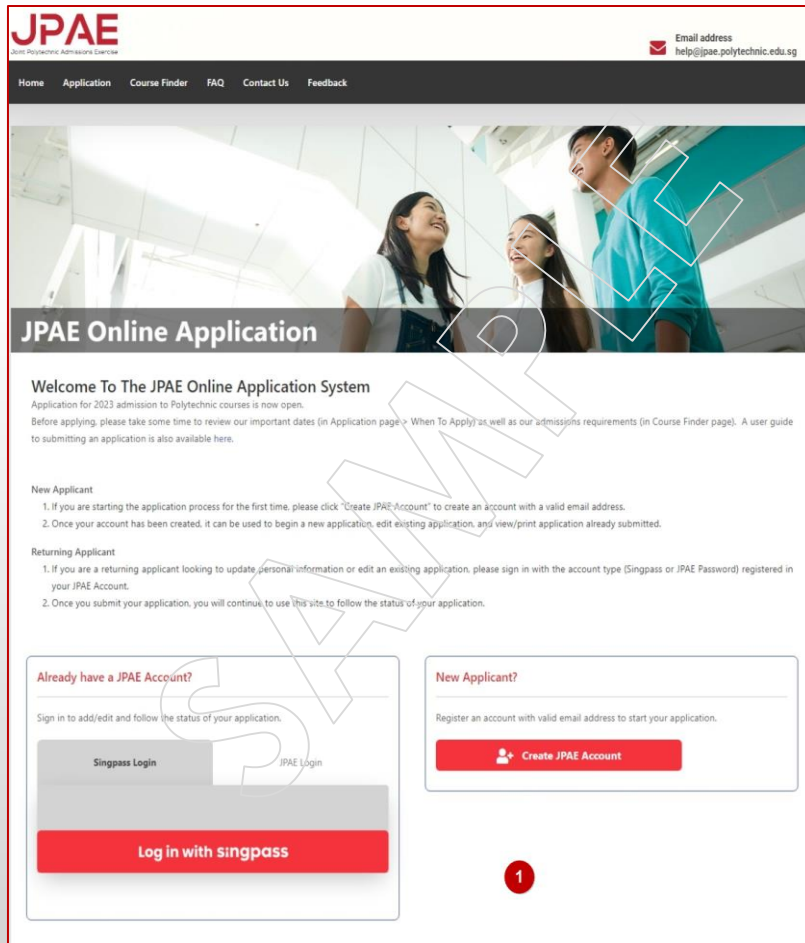

STEP 2: CREATE ACCOUNT

STEP 2B: CREATE JPAE PASSWORD ACCOUNT

Once you click on “Create JPAE Account” button, these are the steps you need to do to create JPAE Password account :

1. Select JPAE Password as Account Type
2. Enter the required information. Password must have at least 12 characters containing upper case letters, lower case letters, numbers and symbols. Password should not contain NRIC/FIN and spaces.
3. Click “Create Account” button
